AL: Tigers Bounce Royals 7-3

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (AP) — Miguel Cabrera homered and drove in four runs and Dontrelle Willis turned in six solid innings in the first regular-season start in almost 10 months, leading the Detroit Tigers to a 7-3 victory over the Kansas City Royals on Thursday. The Royals bullpen blew three saves in the season-opening three-game series against the Tigers. Eddie Bonine (1-0) pitched an inning, giving up three hits.

ATHLETICS 6, MARINERS 2: OAKLAND, Calif. (AP) — Brett Anderson pitched shutout ball in the seventh inning of a strong season debut, Daric Barton drove in a career-high four runs and the Athletics beat Seattle to take the first of four in the AL West rivalry series.

Anderson (1-0) allowed three hits, struck out four and walked one. Seattle starter Doug Fister (0-1), on the opening day roster for the first time after making 11 appearances last season, gave up two runs and six hits in four innings, struck out two and walked three.

BLUE JAYS 3, RANGERS 1: ARLINGTON, Texas (AP) — Vernon Wells hit his fourth homer in three games and Toronto rallied for three runs in the ninth against coach Frank Francisco. Rangers starter C.J. Class AA Boys' All-State Team Announced

HURON — Five seniors and a junior were first-team selections on the Class AA boys' basketball all-state team, which is chosen by the South Dakota Basketball Coaches Association and the South Dakota Sportswriters Association. Four of the six players helped their teams to the Class AA state tournament in Rapid City. Jared Hannigan of Aberdeen Central The senior had averages of 21.4 points, 7.8 rebounds, 3.1 assists and 2.2 steals in leading the Golden Eagles in to the state championship game, where he scored a game-high 29 points. "Jared had the ability to dominate a basketball game on both ends of the floor," Aberdeen Central coach Brent Norberg said. "He was a tremendous athlete with an unselfish attitude. He was willing to do whatever it took to try and win and he was a leader on and off the floor during his four-year career."

Hannigan, who will continue his basketball career at Northern State University in the fall, was the top scorer and rebounded for the Golden Eagles this season. He also led the team in steals.

Hannigan was selected as the Class AA Player of the Year this season and was the Spirit of SU award winner at the state tournament, as well as being named to the all-tour-

ney team and as the 2010 Gatorade Player of the Year.

During his basketball career at Aberdeen Central, Hannigan scored 1,184 points and was a three-time all-Eastern South Dakota Conference player.

Glenn Jackson, Rapid City Central The senior averaged 19.1 points, 8.1 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.8 steals this season in leading the Cobblers to a fourth-place finish in the state tournament.

Jackson is described by Rapid City Central coach Mike Purcell as being a multi-position player, who is very athletic, quick and strong, along with being very intelligent in game situations.

"Glenn can defend the No. 1 to 5 positions on the court," Purcell said. "He enjoys the game, plays with a smile and thrives for competition."

This young man has worked his way to the AA all-state team," he said. "He was in jeopardy of not making the Central High School out when he was a sophomore and decided to dedicate time to the gym and develop skills."

Terrill Newton, Huron The senior averaged 16.4 points, 9.8 rebounds, 6.7 assists and 2.2 steals in helping the Tigers to third-place finish in the state tournament this season.

"Terrill has become one of the best basketball players in the state, not just leading his team in scoring," Huron coach Tim Buddenhagen said. "Terrill possesses the ability to get an open teammate the ball in a scoring position. He has the ability to see things two or three moves ahead of the defense and has a tremendous basketball IQ."
