take it as a derogatory term," Johnson said. "But we tried to use it with the utmost respect. We are proud to be the Fighting Sioux."

Across campus, at the office of American Indian Student Services, senior BJ Rainbow said he had mixed feelings about the end of the dispute.

"My hope is that, of course, the backlash will be minimal," Rainbow said. "Realistically, I don't think that is going to happen."

Robert Kelley, the second-year UND president who stayed on the sidelines while the high education board debated the issue, held a forum Friday to discuss the nickname.

"Yes, unequivocally, we will not return to the Flickertails," Kelley said.
