May Peace Be With You

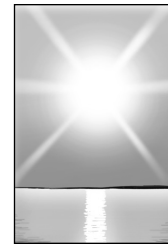

The scripture used this past Sunday in many churches was from the Gospel of John, chapter 20, and verses 19-31. If you did not hear it this past Sunday, I would encourage you to read it now. It begins with the words, "When it was evening on that day..." "That day" is the day we now call Easter Sunday. It was the evening of the day of Jesus' resurrection.

This is one of my favorite scriptures to preach on; maybe because it talks about Thomas and the doubts he had about Jesus actually being alive; maybe because it talks about the disciples being afraid and placing themselves in a room with the doors not only being shut, but being locked. They had good reason to be afraid. Jesus had been crucified. They were followers of Jesus. Maybe the same people who killed Jesus also wanted to kill his followers.

Do you have any reason to be afraid? Is there anything in your life that causes you to doubt? Do you ever want to shut yourself up behind locked doors?

I suspect most people who read this column have heard by now that my family and I are going to be moving to Sioux Falls around the first of July. Yankton has been our home

for 14 years. But I have been appointed by our bishop to Sunnycrest UMC in Sioux Falls. In the United Methodist Church, pastors are "appointed" by bishops. In other denominations, pastors are "called" by a particular congregation. So this is not necessarily something I wanted to happen at this time. My family and I are quite happy living and serving in Yankton. But in this case, the bishop feels my gifts for ministry are needed in another church. So that's where I will go.

I share this because at this time in my life, I have some of those doubts I asked about above. At times right now, it may even be true that I have some fear. And there is a part of me that would like to close the doors outside the city of Yankton and lock them — with me inside! You see, I'm not sure what to expect in Sioux Falls. I've never really thought of myself living there or serving a church there. As you well know, it's a much bigger city than Yankton. What will be expected of me as the pastor of a church in a large city? Do I have what it takes to pastor a church in Sioux Falls? Yes, there is a little fear, and even at times, some doubts.

But I keep falling back on my faith. You see, I believe that when God calls us to do something, He will give us what we need to complete the task. And I believe that when God calls us to do something, He doesn't just send us off by ourselves; He goes with us and walks along side of us. (I'd better believe that. The people in my congregation have heard me tell them that many times!) In the scripture that I referred to above, as the disciples are locked in the room, Jesus appears before them and says, "Peace be with you." He doesn't want us to be afraid. He wants us to be at peace with life. And then, the scripture tells us he breathes on them and says, "Receive the Holy Spirit." It is the Holy Spirit who is with us today, guiding us, encouraging us, walking along side of us, helping us to live life unafraid.

I suspect that at times, you too, have some doubts and maybe even some fears. But let me assure you: the same Holy Spirit that is with me is also with you. Jesus does not want you to be afraid of anything that is before you; he wants you to be at peace with all of life. If there are doubts, know that you are not alone; the Holy Spirit is with you. Whatever God is calling you to do or be, He will give you what you need to accomplish the task. May the peace of Christ be with you.
