CHICAGO (AP) — Grains futures traded mixed Friday on the Chicago Board of Trade.

Wheat for May delivery fell 3.75 cents to \$7.5950 a bushel; May corn jumped 42.75 cents to \$7.36 a bushel; May oats gained 7.75 cents to \$3.75 a bushel; while soybeans for May delivery dropped 16.50 cents to \$13.9375 a bushel.

Beef and pork traded mixed on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange. June live cattle edged up 0.28 cent to \$1.2125 a pound; May feeder cattle gained 0.03 cent to \$1.3940 a pound; June lean hogs fell 0.30 cent to \$1.0357 a pound; while May pork bellies were unchanged at \$1.1800 a pound.
