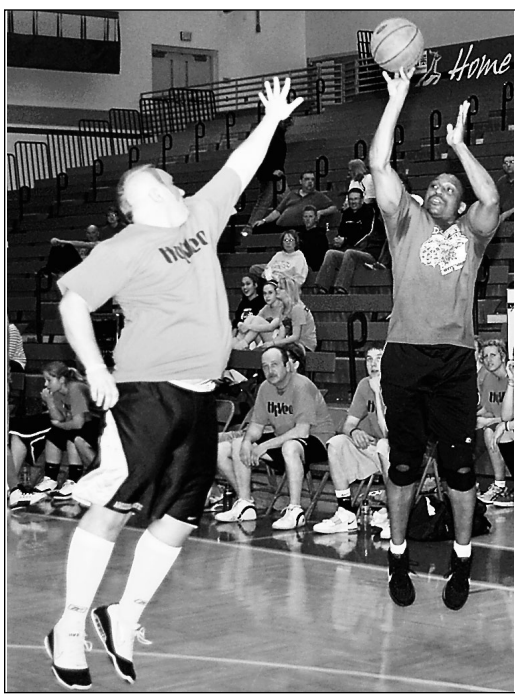

For the Panthers, Matt Luptek, Evan Hendricks and Taylor White were each part of relay victories in the 400 (43.9) and 1600 (3:33.3) relays, as well as one individual title apiece. White won the 100 (11.0), Hendricks won the 400 (51.8) and Luptek took the long jump (20-7 1/4). Zach Sexton filled out the 400 relay. Colton Mahler completed the 1600 relay four-stem. Taylor Lambert won the shot put (48-8 1/2) for Dakota Valley. Sean Fille was a double-winner for Oakland-Craig, claiming both hurdle titles. He clocked a 14.8 in the 110 hurdles and a 42.5 in the 300 hurdles. Allen's D.J. Kennelly won the 800 (2:10.5) and helped the Eagles to victory in the 3200 relay, teaming with Dylan Mahler, Austin Connot and Kyle Finnegan for a clocking of 8:51.9.
