





BOARD OF TRADE

CHICAGO (AP) — Grains futures were mixed Wednesday on the Chicago Board of Trade. Wheat for May delivery jumped 25.75 cents to \$6.9650 a bushel; May corn added 1 cent to \$6.4150 a bushel; May oats fell 5.50 cents to \$3.62 a bushel; while May soybeans fell 13.75 cents to \$13.8025 a bushel. Beef and pork prices were also mixed on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange. June live cattle rose 0.38 cent to \$1.2320 a pound; May feeder cattle fell 0.53 cent to \$1.4657 a pound; June lean hogs added 0.62 cent to 92.47 cents a pound.
