on usage when it threatens to overwhelm the water system's capacity.

According to projections done by HDR, Inc., the consultant hired by the city to develop a water system plan, the maximum daily demand in 2015 is will be 8.2 MGD. By 2035, it is expected to be 10 MGD.

Demand on an average day from 1994-2011 was 2.35 MGD. In 2035, that is projected to be 3.26 MGD.

À tentative plan has been assembled with the assistance of HDR to address the city's intake, treatment and capacity issues. As the planning process goes forward, adjustments may have to be made.

However, Nelson anticipates a plan will be solidified by the end of summer.

The first hurdle is figuring out how the city will obtain water.

An investigation is being done into the possibility of building a collector well at Paddle Wheel Point to replace the current surface water intake pipe near the Discovery Bridge. The test results of the well investigation should be available to the City Commission by late May or early June.

Meanwhile, city officials are also having conversations with representatives of B-Y Water about the possibility of the rural water district selling Yankton water. According to Nelson, that water would still need to undergo some treatment before reaching city water consumers. However, it would be far different than treating water from a collector well or some other source.

Once the city has settled upon a water source, it can then focus on what needs to be done with its water treatment facilities.

Under the proposed plan using collector well water, a new plant would be built adjacent to Water Plant No. 2, which is just to the east of the Meridian Bridge. It would have the capacity to treat 5 MGD. Plant No. 2, which can also treat 5 MGD, would also remain in use for peaking periods. Meanwhile, Treatment Plant No. 1, located on the east side of the Discovery Bridge, would no longer be used for treatment purposes. Under the proposed
