we can coordinate resources provided in the community so we can have more efficiency and effectiveness," Wenande stated.

"As far as political endeavors, I don't know if and when I would jump back into the ring on anything," she added. "I absolutely love city government and had a lot of fun doing it. I like being involved with what happens in Yankton. Whether on the commission or not, I'm hoping to participate on some level in keeping projects moving forward.

Wenande said there are a lot of things she is proud to have been a part of during the last decade.

"As a commissioner, you are part of a team," she noted. "It's the team that accomplishes things — not individuals.'
