"It's a sense of accomplishment." Skorepa's biggest motivation is her competitors.

"Any person that is better than me honestly pushes me. When it comes to track you can learn a lot just from watching, so when a really good thrower comes along I will watch them and try to learn from that," she said.

After Skorepa completes her senior year, she will be attending Concordia University (Seward, Nebraska) to study Elementary Education and to participate in track and field.
