

**Gator Found In Kiddie Pool Gets A New Home**

SCOTTSDLUFF, Neb. (AP) — An alligator being kept illegally as a pet in western Nebraska is getting a new home in either Colorado or New Mexico.

The *Scottsbluff Star-Herald* reports that the 8-year-old, 4-foot-long alligator named Sprinkles was found in a home last month, where it was being kept in a kiddie pool.

Sprinkles was taken to the Riverside Discovery Center zoo in Scottsbluff. Zookeeper Adrienne Leopard, who once worked at an alligator sanctuary in Alabama, says the female alligator appears to be in good shape, although her growth may have been stunted in confinement.

The alligator is now at the Colorado Gators Rescue Park in Mosca, Colorado, where she may stay or be sent to a zoo in Albuquerque.

**ELDER ABUSE**

South Dakota officials want to better understand the scope of elder abuse in the state through a new task force on the topic, and the governor signed into law a measure to create an interim committee dedicated to studying the prevalence of financial, physical and emotional abuse.

The bill was spurred by Chief Justice of the Supreme Court David Gilbertson, who urged lawmakers to focus on the issue in his State of the Judiciary speech this year.
