Adrian Fiala, Former Nebraska Lb And Broadcaster, Dies At 67

LINCOLN, Neb. (AP) — Adrian Fiala, who played football for Nebraska in the 1960s and later worked as a broadcaster covering the Cornhuskers, has died. He was 67.

Fiala's wife, Fran, told the *Lincoln Journal Star* that her husband had been battling an incurable lung condition for eight years. He died Monday afternoon.

Fiala played at Ryan High School in Omaha before joining Bob Devaney's up-and-coming football program. He lettered three years as a linebacker, with the Huskers finishing 9-2 and tying for first place in the Big Eight in his senior season in 1969. He also was the catcher on the baseball team.

Fiala was a color analyst on Huskers radio broadcasts from 2000-10 and also was a fixture on the popular statewide "Big Red Wrapup" show on public television.

Crofton Girls, Wausa Boys Win Knox County Titles

CREIGHTON, Neb. — The Crofton girls and Wausa boys ran away with top honors at the Knox County Invitational track and field meet, held on Monday in Creighton, Nebraska. The meet was originally scheduled for April 7, but was postponed due to rain.

The Crofton girls won 11 events on the way to 199 points, well ahead of runner-up Creighton's 86. Maria Wortmann was a part of four wins for Crofton, taking both the shot put (40-8) and discus (128-9) and helping the Lady Warriors to victory in the 400 (54.8) and 1600 (4:21.7) relays. Haley Arens swept the 1600 (5:32.2) and 3200 (12:38.6). Kelsey Sanger (300 hurdles, 51.3) and Quinn Wragge (400, 1:03.7) were each part of two relay wins and had one individual victory. Allison Arens was also on two relay wins.

Boyd County's Tori Wendell earned two individual victories, in the 100 (13.7) and long jump (15-3 1/2).

On the boys' side, four-event winner Austin Hegge helped the Vikings, who beat out Creighton 136-117 for the team title. Hegge won the 100 (11.4), 200 (23.2), long (20-0 3/4) and triple (42-11) jumps. Also for the Vikings, Kyle Kleinschmit swept the 110- (17.1) and 300-meter (43.7) hurdles, and Nick Story won the 800 (2:13.2) and helped the Vikings to victory in the 3200 relay (9:08.7).

Boyd County's Blake Ahlers swept the distance races, taking the 1600 in 5:00.6 and the 3200 in 11:18.2. Creighton's Brandon Borgmann and Brook Baller were a part of two relay victories for the bulldogs, the 400 (47.2) and 1600 relays (3:53.1).
