USD's Minogue Earns SL Honors

ELMHURST, Ill. — South Dakota junior first baseman Yvon Minogue (Corona, Calif.) has been named The Summit League Player of the Week for the period ended April 12. It's the second career award for Minogue and second this season.

Minogue batted .824 (14-for-17) with three home runs, three doubles and a triple in five games while driving in eight and scoring 14 runs. She broke USD's 22-year-old record for doubles in a season (21) and leads the nation in that category. She drew three walks for an on-base percentage of .857 and had a slugging percentage of 1.647.

Minogue tallied at least two base hits in all five games, helping the Coyotes score a record 20 runs Wednesday at Creighton and then matching that figure Saturday against Fort Wayne.

Minogue leads the Summit League in batting average (.481), hits (63), doubles (21) and total bases (109). She is second in the league in on-base percentage (.524), slugging percentage (.832), runs scored (42) and triples (2).

North Dakota State's Krista Menke earned Pitcher of the Week honors for the second straight week and 17th time in her career after leading NDSU to a three-game sweep of South Dakota State. She continues to lead the NCAA in strikeouts, now with 275.

Huron Golfer Signs With MMC

Huron's Taylor Flanery will attend Mount Marty College and participate in the women's golf program for the Lancers, the institution announced Monday.

Flanery finished 44th in the 2014 South Dakota State Class AA Girls' Golf tournament, helping the Tigers to a fifth place team finish. She was named the team's most improved golfer last season.

"Taylor will be a solid addition to our golf program here at MMC," said MMC women's golf coach Tom Schlimgen. "She has a lot of good experience and she will be a good fit at Mount Marty College."

The daughter of Tim and Adele Flanery, Taylor plans to major in nursing at MMC. She will receive an Academic Honors Scholarship and a Catholic Leadership Award in addition to her golf scholarship.

MMC Softball Inks JC Infielder

Amanda McCafferty of Parkdale, Oregon, currently playing for Southwestern Oregon Community College, will attend Mount Marty College and play softball for the Lancers, according to an announcement from MMC.

McCafferty is batting .394 on the 2015 season with three doubles, 13 hits and 12 RBI in 33 at-bats. She hit .308 in limited action in 2014. As a senior at Hood River Valley High School, she earned second-team all-league honors.

"She was a great high school player and will have two years of college experience under her belt," said MMC head softball coach Albert Fernandez. "She is a great student and will fit well with our team and the Mount Marty College community."

Besides her on the field prowess, McCafferty was on the Dean's list and honor roll while also being a member of the Youth Heart of Hospice.

The daughter of Mike and Tammy McCafferty, Amanda plans to major in nursing at MMC. She will receive an Academic Merit Scholarship in addition to her softball award.
