Currently the restoration of the windows on the first floor is underway. We are salvaging, re-storing and reusing as much of the original material as possible rather than building all new windows. Sometimes this requires some innovation, like this curing box designed to provide constant heat so the glues and paints on the windows can dry at a consistent rate.
