USD's Barrett Named Summit League Athlete Of The Week

ELMHURST, Ill.—South Dakota junior Kelsey Barrett has been named the Summit League Outdoor Track and Field Athlete of the Week for the period ended April 26, as released by the league office on Tuesday.

Barrett picks up her first career Athlete of the Week honor after capturing the 10,000-meter title at the Drake Relays. The Britton native dropped more than three minutes off her personal best when she clocked 34 minutes, 54.45 seconds. Her time ranks second in the Summit League this season and second in all-time school history.

Barrett and the Coyotes compete at the Howard Wood Relays in Sioux Falls on Friday and Saturday.

Barrett shared women's honors with Maddie Van Beek of NDSU, who won the steeplechase at Drake Relays with a personal-best time of 10:15.03.

Area Bowlers Among State Tournament Leaders

Several area bowlers are among the leaders through three weeks of various state bowling tournaments going on throughout the state.

At the Open Tournaments, being held through May 17 in Sioux Falls, CorTrust Bank of Vermillion ranks second in the 'B' handicapped division with a 2,750. Werk-Weld #2 of Armour (2,675) ranks fourth, with Yankton's Captain & Crew (2,673) fifth and Tabor's Corner Bar (2,617) tenth.

In the handicap doubles 'B' division, Vermillion's Greg Bogenpohl and Larry Wittmeier rank fifth at 1,372. Bogenpohl also ranks fourth in the all-events handicap with a 2,183.

In the handicap singles 'A' division, Marion's Barry Wollman ranks ninth at 737. Yankton's

Ryan Liebl ranks ninth in the 'B' singles division at 746.

In the 700 Tournament, also being held in Sioux Falls, Parkston's Daren Lindeman ranks eighth in the 'A' division at 1,401, while Vermillion's Brad Hansen ranks fourth in the 'B' division with a 1,263.

In the senior tournament, also being held in Sioux Falls, Mike Kruse, Sr., of Vermillion ranks fifth (1,369) and Mike Barta of Vermillion ranks ninth (1,270) in the 'A' division, while Donald Lucas of Platte ranks fourth (1,214) in the 'B' division.

In the youth tournament, being held through May 3 in Huron, the Vermillion Rollers (2,786) and Yankton's Mixed Up (2,760) rank second and fourth in the team 500-599 division.

In doubles competition, Yankton's Tyler Johnson and Brennan Metteer ranks eighth in the 200-249 division at 1,393. Yankton's Joe Losing and Josh Bern rank sixth in the 250-299 division at 1,338.

In boys' singles, Yankton's Carter Tepy ranks eighth in the 100-124 division at 706. Bern ranks third in the 125-149 division at 748. Bern also leads the boys' all-event handicap in his division with a 2,172, with Johnson ranking fourth at 2,072. Bern (1,551) and Johnson (1,514) rank first and second in the scratch all-event in their division, while Tepy ranks sixth in the all-events scratch at 1,226. Bern also leads the optional scratch event for 159-under at 541.

In girls' singles, Yankton's Maia Achen ranks fourth in the 99-under division at 725. Yankton's Kellia Barta ranks fourth in the 150-over division at 675.
