STILLWATER, Okla. — Vermillion High School senior state champion Brett Bye was the South Dakota winner of the Dave Schultz High School Excellence Award for 2015, as announced by the National Wrestling Hall of Fame & Museum.

Originally created in honor of Schultz, an Olympic and World champion, the High School Excellence Award is based

on excellence in wrestling, scholastic achievement, citizenship and community service. State winners for both the Schultz awards (boys) and Tricia Saunders awards (girls) were selected in each of the states that sponsor high school state championships. There are 49 boys state winners, and seven on the girls' side.

Bye, a South Dakota State University recruit, finished his senior season undefeated at 43-0 and with a second consecutive state championship.

## Hampshire Honor Society Picks Eight From SDSU

IRVING, Texas — Eight members of

the 2014 South Dakota State University football senior class were named Wednesday to the 2015 Hampshire Honor Society by the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame.

To be honored, student-athletes must maintain at least a 3.2 cumulative grade-point average throughout their entire course of undergraduate study and meet all NCAA-mandated progress toward degree requirements and graduation. A total of 817 players from 278 schools across all divisions of college football received recognition as a member of the Hampshire Honor Society.

The Jackrabbit honorees included Andrew Mueller, offensive lineman, Peculiar, Mo.; Nick Purcell, offensive lineman, Rapid City; Ethan Sawyer, punter, Brandon; Jason Schneider, wide receiver, Andover, Minn.; Justin Syro-

vatka, kicker, Sioux Falls; Eric Tuschen, defensive lineman, Sioux Falls; Dom Wright, wide receiver/kick returner, Lee's Summit, Mo.; and Zach Zenner, running back, Eagan, Minn.

SDSU's honorees excelled both on the football field and in the classroom. Syrovatka and Zenner were All-America selections following the 2014 season, while Purcell, Schneider and Zenner were each named to the Capital One Academic All-America First Team.

The Jackrabbit football program has been represented well in the nine-year history of the Hampshire Honor Society as 48 different players have been selected for induction.
