Recreation and the Yankton School District were also involved in putting the bid together.

"The Convention and Visitors Bureau, City of Yankton Parks and Recreations Department, Yankton School District and the local Special Olympics Chapter worked together to submit a bid to be the host community," Scheve said. "This will be a large undertaking so it was important to have all facilities on board with the project."

Once the bid was completed, the awarding of the bid came as little surprise.

"We've had the Southeast Area tournament here the past few years, so we knew the state officials had seen our facilities and were impressed by them," Putnam said. "Mitchell doesn't have one facility with five or six courts, and when you are dealing with several different venues, it makes scheduling of games difficult."

The tournament has the potential to bring nearly 1,000 people, half of which are Special Olympians, to Yankton during the two days of the event. With the tournament guaranteed to be in Yankton for three years, the hard work to land the event will reap many rewards, according to Scheve.

"This is a special one, because we'll host it for three years," she said. "A lot of times when we bid (on a tourney), it's for one year."

Bringing the tournament has one small downside for the local athletes.

"They're probably a little disappointed, because (the state tournament) is one of the few times they get to travel, stay in a hotel and maybe play in the pool," Putnam noted. "But they will be able to go home to their own beds. And we're excited because, after a long day, we'll be able to go home to ours."

Organizers are looking for organizations and individuals interested in offering their support to the tournaments, from volunteering, assist with logistics, banquet for athletes and other duties.
