AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF YANKTON BY AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS THEREIN

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF YANKTON, SOUTH DAKOTA THAT:

CHAPTER 3, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Chapter 3 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES*

Sec. 3-5. Times when on-and off-sale service is prohibited.

No on-sale or off-sale licensee shall sell, serve, or allow to be consumed on the premises covered by the license any alcoholic beverage between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. daily or at any time on Christmas Day.

SIOUX FALLS (AP) — U.S. Sen. Tim Johnson has been released from a Sioux Falls hospital after gallbladder surgery earlier in the week. Johnson's office says the South Dakota Democrat left Avera McKennan Hospital on Thursday and will continue his recovery at home. Johnson says he's glad to be "on the mend."

Neb. High Court Won't Reconsider Ousting Of Judge

LINCOLN, Neb. (AP) — The Nebraska Supreme Court won't reconsider its decision to oust a North Platte judge accused of misconduct. The high court on Wednesday dismissed a motion from former Lincoln County Judge Kent Florum seeking another hearing in his case. The high court ordered Florum's removal on July 9 because he tried to influence cases involving a coach and player on his daughter's softball team. The judge, who admitted improper behavior, had been on the bench for 19 years with no indication of other wrongdoing. In its July ruling, the high court said the facts of Florum's misconduct are largely undisputed because he admitted the improper behavior, so it needed only to decide whether suspension or removal was appropriate. Justices ruled that Florum's behavior was egregious and prolonged enough to warrant removal. Florum said Thursday he had no comment on the court's latest decision. A complaint filed last year accused the judge of improperly involving himself in two cases between March and July 2008. One involved North Platte teacher and softball coach Sharon Kramer, who was accused of stealing from a high school booster club concession stand, and the other involved a softball player facing criminal charges. Florum, who helped coach the team, recused himself from both cases. But court documents say he asked a prosecutor if charges against Kramer could be dropped, suggested she be sentenced without an open hearing and threatened a school board member. In the softball player's case, Florum told a prosecutor to "take care of my shortstop" and contacted the assigned caseworker several times, the documents said.

Neb. Authorities Suspect Cat Has Plague

GERING, Neb. (AP) — Health officials in western Nebraska say a pet cat from the area likely has the plague. Scotts Bluff County Health Department director Bill Wineman says the cat was taken last week to a Gering animal hospital from a northeast Scotts Bluff County home. Wineman says the cat was displaying clinical symptoms of the plague, although tests results on blood samples taken from the cat were inconclusive. Wineman says another pet cat in the area tested positive for plague two years ago. Wineman says the health department wants to make residents in the area aware of the latest suspected case. Plague is a bacterial disease in wild rodents that can be transmitted to domestic animals and humans through the bite of infected fleas.

S.D. Boy Dies After Being Left In Hot Car

DE SMET (AP) — The Kingsbury County sheriff's office says a young boy has died after being left in his car seat for several hours during hot weather. Sheriff Kevin Scotting says the boy died about 12:30 p.m. Wednesday, before paramedics arrived at the home in rural Kingsbury County. Outside temperatures on Wednesday reached 90 degrees. Scotting says the boy's father put him in his car seat, but it wasn't clear why he was left unattended for so long. Scotting hasn't released the names of the boy or his parents, citing the ongoing investigation. He says the child was less than a year old.

Motorcycle Collides With Five Other Cycles

HULETT, Wyo. (AP) — A motorcycle crossed into the wrong lane in northeast Wyoming and caused a group of six other approaching motorcycles to wreck, killing one person and injuring five others. The Wyoming Highway Patrol says the accident occurred Wednesday afternoon on Wyoming 24, about three miles east Hulett. The patrol says 64-year-old Donald Ulmer, of Grenfell, Saskatchewan, died. It says Ulmer was eastbound at a high rate of speed when his motorcycle crossed the center line of the two-lane highway and went into a group of six oncoming cycles. Five of the other motorcyclists were taken to hospitals in Rapid City and Spearfish in South Dakota. A sixth cyclist was treated and released. The patrol says none of the cyclists was wearing a helmet and the accidents remains under investigation.

Neb. Man Killed In Mowing Accident

SCRIBNER, Neb. (AP) — A Scribner man has died after being pinned beneath a tractor while mowing ditches. Dodge County Sheriff Steve Hespen says 70-year-old Marlyn Peters was using a tractor and sickle mower three miles south of Scribner on Wednesday morning when it rolled over. Peters was pinned and died at the scene.
