All weekend the kids can have fun at the Children's Activity Tent. You can't miss this free activity located under the big blue tent by the amphitheatre.

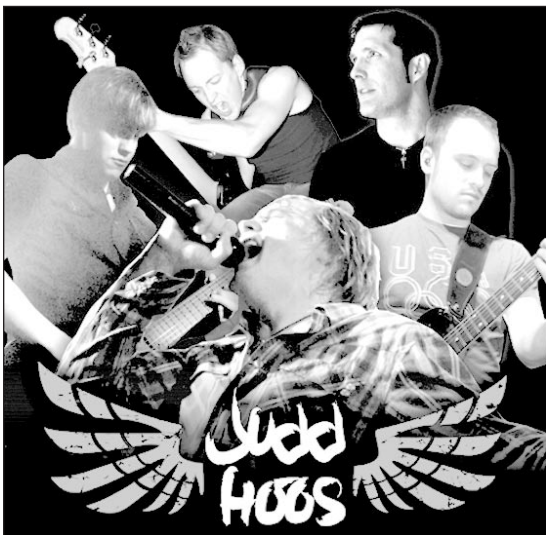
Also Down At The River:

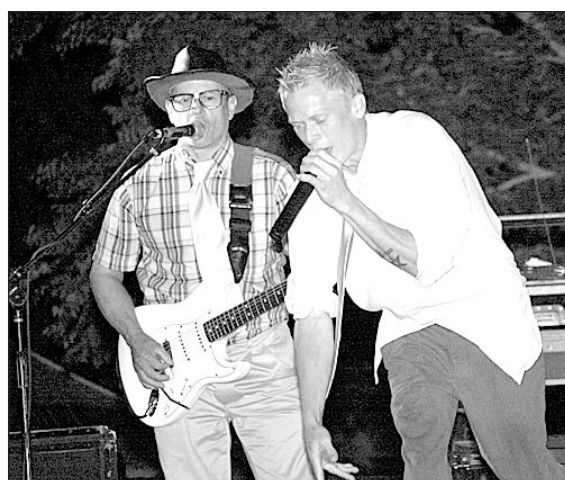
They will be performing at 8 p.m. Friday, Aug. 20, at the parking lot north of the Beverage Shelter. Stick around after the concert for the annual fireworks show
