You can find him under the Children's Tent.

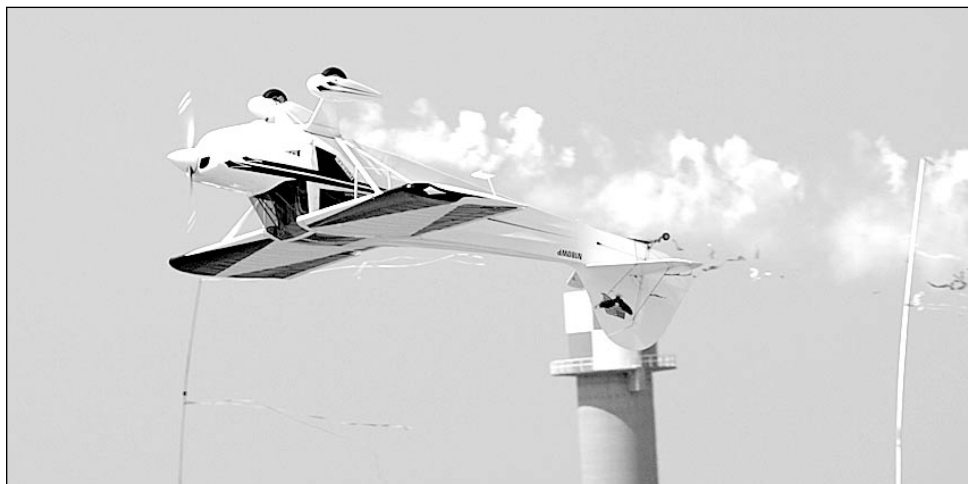
Pietsch Air Show
