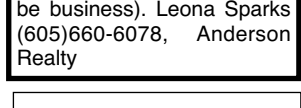

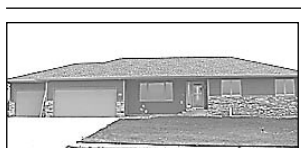

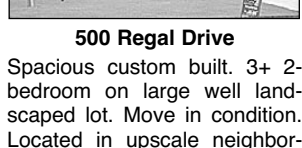

out so we can talk to folks about what we do with resource management, and how we monitor the river and certain species, and all of the equipment that goes along with that," Wagner said.

Another display is the "stream table," which helps to explain the process of sedimentation. "It basically shows how a natural river works," Doherty-Stephan said. "You can also make changes to it. You could put up a dam or you can build a sandbar by just manipulating it, so people see what happens to the way the natural river functions when it's altered."

"It's something you can really stick your hands in. It's kind of fun for kids of all ages," Wagner added.

Volunteer opportunities will also be addressed. "That's really important for us to develop," Wagner said. "We just want to show people how they can get involved in a positive way."

Community members can also join the group's mailing list if they are interested in learning about and participating in various types of public meetings, educational programming and other ways to get involved.

For the younger crowd, the Riverboat Days booth will provide a number of different activities.

"We'll have steamboat races. As long as supplies last, we've got about 100 kits where kids can put together their own steamboat to decorate," Doherty-Stephan said. "We'll have some activities where they can learn about the water cycle and make a water cycle bracelet. We'll have steamboat coloring sheets."

At 1:30 p.m. and 3 p.m. both Saturday and Sunday, a living history program will be presented.

"One of our seasonal interpreters is developing a special costumed interpretation program, where he'll be portraying a combined character of a second clerk aboard one of Great Marsh's vessels," Doherty-Stephan said.

Stating that the Yankton manufacturing community is recovering more quickly than may be expected, Svatos said the demand for highly skilled workers would soon outgrow the supply present in Yankton. Because of that, it is a good idea to have the educators at the job fair, he said.

"The saying goes, 'When opportunity knocks, you need to take it,' he said. 'Anytime you can better yourself, do it. By letting job seekers see what opportunities there are both now and in the future with further education, you are giving them the best opportunity to make decisions for the future. There will be something for everyone here.'

Employers that will be at the event are Applied Engineering, Kolberg-Pioneer, Vishay Dale Electronics, the Human Services Center, Avera Sacred Heart Hospital, Farm Bureau Financial Services, Avera Majestic Bluffs, Avera Yankton Care Center, First National Bank South Dakota, L&M Radiator, Southeast Job Link, Baldwin Filters, HyVee, Sapa, Gehl Company, Manpower, the Press & Dakotan and Dakota Trailer.

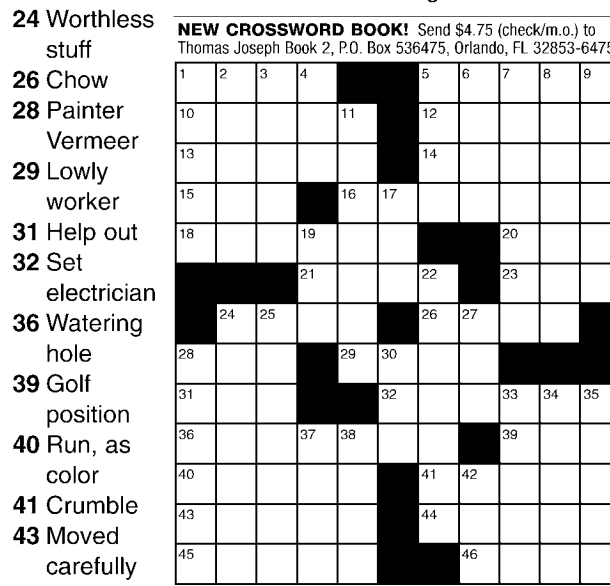
