**Bad News On Homes Adds To Recession**

WASHINGTON — It's starting to feel like another recession.

Businesses are ordering fewer goods. Home sales are the slowest in decades. Jobs are scarce, and unemployment claims are rising.

Perhaps most worrisome, manufacturing activity, which had been one of the economy's few bright spots, is faltering.

"The odds of a double-dip are rising and uncomfortably high," said Mark Zandi, chief economist at Moody's Analytics, referring to the possibility that the nation will tip back into recession.

"Nothing else can go wrong. There is no cushion left."

On Wednesday, the government offered the latest dose of grim news about the economic recovery: Companies cut back last month on their investments in equipment and machines.

And Americans bought new homes at the weakest pace in nearly half a century.

Earlier this week came news that sales of previously occupied homes fell last month to the lowest level in 15 years.

Unemployment remains near double digits because job growth in the private sector has slowed.

The economy has grown for a full year now, and many experts believe the recession technically ended in July 2009. But the pace of expansion has slowed significantly in the past six months.

Economists are predicting the government will announce Friday that the economy grew from April to June even more slowly than previously thought, at an annual rate below 2 percent — weak for normal times and especially anemic right after a recession.

**Pentagon Computers Attacked**

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Pentagon says a foreign spy agency pulled off the most serious breach of Defense Department computer networks ever by inserting a flash drive into a U.S. military laptop.

The previously classified incident took place in 2008 in the Middle East and was disclosed in a magazine article by Deputy Defense Secretary William J. Lynn and released by the Pentagon Wednesday. The Pentagon did not say what nation's spy agency was involved.

He said a "malicious code" on the flash drive spread undetected on both classified and unclassified Pentagon systems, "establishing what amounted to a digital beachhead" for stealing military secrets.

He did not say what, if any, information was taken.

**Wal-Mart Asks To Overturn Lawsuit**

WASHINGTON (AP) — Wal-Mart Stores Inc. has asked the Supreme Court to throw out a massive class action lawsuit alleging gender discrimination over pay for female workers.

Wal-Mart is the world's largest private employer and could face billions of dollars in legal damages if the lawsuit is heard and it loses.

The 9th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals ruled in April that Wal-Mart should face charges in court that it pays women less than men for the same jobs.

The lawsuit was first filed by six women in federal court in 2001. They also allege that female employees receive fewer promotions and have to wait longer for those promotions.

The company, based in Bentonville, Ark., filed its appeal with the Supreme Court on Wednesday.

**Spill Panel Probes Decision To Drill**

WASHINGTON (AP) — The chairmen of the presidential panel investigating the Gulf oil spill are expressing disappointment that the Obama administration didn't consult with senior U.S. environmental officials before announcing plans to expand offshore drilling before the accident.

The exchange during a hearing Wednesday suggests that a focus of the federal investigation will be the degree to which federal scientists were consulted in oil and gas decisions.

Both the chairwoman of the Council on Environmental Quality and the head of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration told the panel they were not directly involved in Obama's March announcement to expand offshore drilling.

The president said at the time it was a decision weighed carefully for over a year.

**Biden: GOP Tax Cut Claims "malarkey"**

WASHINGTON (AP) — Vice President Joe Biden says Republican assertions that small businesses would suffer if all of the expiring Bush tax cuts aren't extended are a "bunch of malarkey."

A series of sweeping tax cuts enacted under President George W. Bush are set to expire in January.

The Obama administration wants to renew only those tax breaks that affect middle-class and lower income taxpayers, those with incomes under \$250,000. Republicans want the tax cuts extended for all wage-earners.

Biden said Wednesday that few small businesses would benefit if the tax cuts are extended for everyone. Doing so, he said, would cost \$700 billion, worsen the nation's already dire financial situation and, in his words, is "just bad economic policy."
