Cleanup Work On Neb. Highway 12 Begins

LINCOLN, Neb. — The Nebraska Department of Roads has begun cleanup work on Highway 12 between Niobrara and the Santee Spur. While the approximately four-mile stretch of Highway 12 remains closed, residents may see construction equipment accessing the highway. Water still covers portions of the road, but Department of Roads workers are removing debris left behind by the floodwaters. Inspections and testing of the roadway surface and road bed will be performed, and repair efforts will begin as soon as possible. The date when the highway will be reopened to traffic is unknown at this time. Drivers are reminded to heed the "Road Closed" signs and barriers.
