USD Picked Fourth In Great West Preseason Football Poll

NAPERVILLE, Ill. — The University of South Dakota football team has been picked to finish fourth in the Great West Conference in a vote of the league's coaches, the conference office announced Wednesday.

"We always appreciate the Great West Conference coaches' opinion, but we have 95 players and 11 coaches in Vermillion who think we can win this thing," eighth-year head coach Ed Meierkort said.

The Coyotes received 13 points in the voting after posting a 4-7 record overall and a 1-3 mark in conference play in 2010. South Dakota returns 19 starters and 53 letterwinners for 2011. North Dakota was selected fifth with six points.

SUU and Cal Poly each had two first-place votes, while UC Davis garnered one first-place vote. The Thunderbirds edged Cal Poly 20-19 in total points.
