One of this year's recipients was Arlene Stoebner from Yankton, SD. Arlene Stoebner is a retired elementary teacher from Yankton public schools, where she taught second and fourth grades from 1970 to May 2010. She began teaching Kindergarten at Wakonda Public Schools. She received a BS in education at USD in 1970 and a MA in elementary education in 1975.

Arlene was an active member of the Yankton Education Association, SDEA/NEA, and member and officer of the Yankton Reading Council. She is a volunteer for Meals on Wheels, Bible school teacher, Sunday school teacher, church council member and officer of the United Church of Christ-Congregational church in Yankton. Arlene was "Teacher of the Year"

for Lincoln Elementary School in 2001 and in 2006-07 she was "Teacher of the Year" for the entire Yankton School District.

Nominator Marlys Hauck-Fenner stated that in speaking with the principal in Arlene's building at Lincoln Elementary, he said, "Arlene left a positive impression with her students and worked very well with all her fellow staff members."
