

Facebook Updates iPhone App

MENLO PARK, Calif. (AP) — What's the worst insult you can throw at a fast-moving company like Facebook? Call its iPhone app slow and poky. On Thursday, Facebook Inc. addressed users who had gripes with its app for iPhones and iPads with the launch of a faster version. Rather than add a slew of new features, the company said it rebuilt the application from scratch to make it speedier and less clunky.

In a recent demonstration at the company's Menlo Park, Calif., headquarters, the new iPhone app opened about twice as fast as the older version. Photos and comments also load faster. Users can now "like" comments on photos, which wasn't possible with the previous mobile app. Mick Johnson, mobile product manager at Facebook, said programmers removed some lesser-used features, such as a way to view the app horizontally, to help speed it up.

The mobile arena presents Facebook with its biggest challenge—and its biggest opportunity. That's where its user base is growing the most. At the end of June, Facebook had 543 million users who accessed it with a phone or tablet computer, up 67 percent from 325 million a year earlier. Its overall user base grew 29 percent over the same time period, to 955 million.

But while Facebook ads are well-established on its website, the company only recently started experimenting with mobile advertisements. That's been a concern for investors, who've sent Facebook's stock down by nearly half since the company's initial public offering three months ago.

The iPad version of the new app now features Timeline, the latest version of the profile page that Facebook is rolling out to all of its users. The app is available for free from Apple's App Store.

vided severance packages and access to a variety of outplacement services.

Stream's service center in Vermillion is located in a 20,000-square-foot building at the intersection of Cherry Street and Highway 50 on the city's western edge.

The company's Sergeant Bluff facility is much larger — 148,000 square feet — and can accommodate approximately 1,200 workers.

In early 2011, Stream laid off 250 people at Sergeant Bluff after losing a major client. Approximately a month later, however, the company was looking to hire 500 people in Sergeant Bluff after it added additional gaming platform services for one of their existing consumer electronics clients to the site.

Stream is also pursuing plans to make a major investment in Minnesota, in the Twins Cities area. MorrisAnderson, a financial consulting company with offices in Chicago, reported that Stream is seeking up to \$2 million in funds from the state of Minnesota related to its plans to move its headquarters from Wellesley, Mass., to Eagan, Minn.

The money would pay for renovations, machinery and equipment at the nearly 45,000-square-foot Northwood Business Park Phase I in Eagan, according to documents related to an Eagan Economic Development Authority meeting scheduled for Aug. 6.

It also appears Stream plans to expand its Sergeant Bluff facility while winding down operations in Vermillion.

KTIV television reported Aug. 9 that Stream held a job fair in hopes of hiring 350 new employees for its Iowa facility.

Stream is one of 118 select companies that are a part of Bain Capital Ventures, a private, alternative asset management firm founded in 1984 by current presumptive Republican presidential nominee Mitt Romney and two other partners, T. Coleman Andrews III, and Eric Kriss.

Stream Global Services, which has 33,000 employees working out of 49 locations in 21 countries, lost \$23.6 million and had \$846.9 million in revenue in the fiscal year ending Dec. 31, 2011, down from a loss of \$53.5 million off \$800.2 million in revenue in 2010.

Stream Global Services CEO Kathryn Marinello, who lives in Apple Valley, Minn., has been improving the company's financial performance through investments in infrastructure and people, according to MorrisAnderson.

The company in 2011 invested \$20 million in capital expenditures and spent \$5 million more on agent incentives. The company went private earlier this year.
