CHICAGO (AP) — Grains futures were higher Monday on the Chicago Board of Trade.
Wheat for December delivery rose 10 cents to \$6.535 a bushel; December corn rose 22 cents to \$4.8550 a bushel; December oats were 6.25 cents higher at \$3.3625 a bushel; while November soybeans advanced 44 cents to \$13.0325 a bushel.

Beef was higher and pork prices were lower on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange.
October live cattle rose .15 cent to \$1.2807 a pound; September feeder cattle rose .28 cent to \$1.5795 a pound; while October lean hogs were .25 cent lower at \$8.647 a pound.
