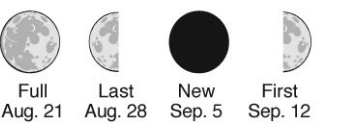

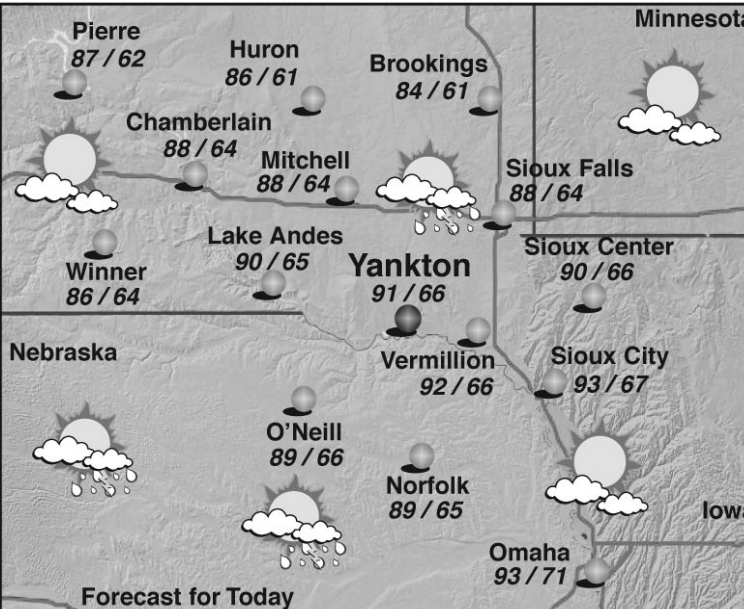

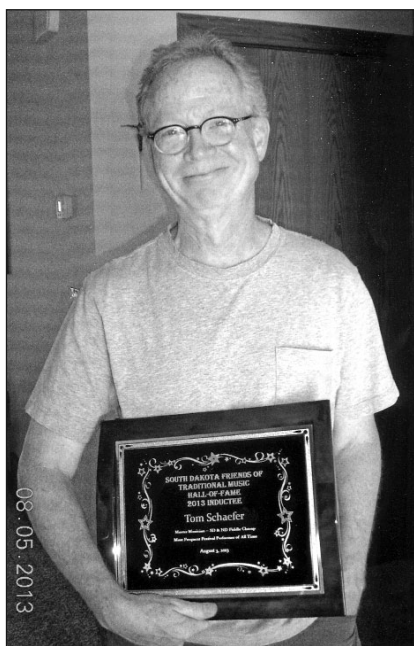
5 Rescued From Mo. River
