Praying For Kids In This Generation

The law: All baby boys destroyed. A baby boy was born. His mother hid him from government authorities. She quickly met the infant's needs so he wouldn't cry. She looked at her son with love and committed many prayers for him. The brave mother secretly hid her son for three months. A day came when she could no longer keep him hidden. With tears, she took her son and put him in a basket. With her older daughter and the baby, they went to the river. She paused, took a deep sigh and looked to heaven with another prayer. "Oh God, keep my baby safe." Looking around she saw no one. Quickly she took the helpless little bundle to the side of the river and put him in a strategic place so he would be found. The infant's older sister watched as the daughter of the powerful leader arrived at the riverside. Seeing the basket and the baby, she ordered it picked up. The sister quickly moves towards the

woman and asks, to find a suitable woman to nurse the baby?" Upon a positive answer, the sister ran to get her mother. 'Mom, come quickly." She ran to the riverside, took her son in her arms and took

him home with the blessings of the murderous government. Many years she cared for her son and instilled a love for the Lord God. The weaned boy went into the powerful palace to live

If you know your Bible, you know that this story is about Moses. Moses came into the world in a hostile, uncaring climate. Today's children must enter an environment not as extreme but also not without dangers.

The mother of Moses had qualities about her that caused her son to rise

above the dangers and change the world of his day. Let's look at those qualities.

She knew her child was special. Many parents feel this way and it's a great start. She was more concerned for her son than she was about her own well-being. As parents pray for their children, a divine love develops in the soul. It's difficult to imagine a murderous climate in which a mom would have to place her son in a basket by the river in hopes to keep him alive. It doesn't make sense to the human mind. It does make sense when we read the entire story. Moses was trained in the enemies' territory. When he became older, he led his people into freedom. This mother prayed a divine protection around her son and God provided the miracle. She didn't have much time with her son. Yet in those few years, under the leading of God, she was instrumental in changing her son's life and in doing that changed a nation -

Schmidt To Perform On Bishop Marty Chapel Organ Sept. 15

David Schmidt, a native of Freeman and an alumni of Mount Marty College, will present an organ recital at 3 p.m., on Sunday afternoon, Sept. 15, at the Bishop Marty Chapel at Sacred Heart Monastery in Yankton.

Schmidt is the Director of Music and principal organist at the Cathedral of the Risen Christ in Lincoln, Neb., a position he has held since 1980. He has been studying and playing the organ since he was 10 years old, learning on his grandmother's home organ. During high school, he studied at Sioux Falls College and while in college at Mt. Marty in Yankton with S. Jane Klimisch, OSB, and Alice Hohenthaner; in Lincoln with Dr. Quentin Faulkner at UNL. Currently he is studying with Dr. Christopher Marks at UNL and improvisation with Tom Trenney of First Plymouth Congregational Church in Lincoln.

The program which he will perform on Sept. 15 follows themes found in the Rule of St. Benedict, the guiding spirit

Schmidt notes that perseverance is another teaching of St. Benedict which he encountered in preparing for this recital. Within the context of that Rule, a novice entering the monastic life is tested to see if they can persevere toward a life in service to God. "Thus, the theme of perseverance

seemed appropriate and has been a motivating factor as this program has been prepared," said Mr. Schmidt. "It would have been much easier to take a broader path of travel and not prepare or even consider a recital, however, staying on the straight and narrow of preparing has truly been a rewarding and satisfying journey as I have practiced for the upcoming program. I learned so many things from the sisters in Yankton in regards to music, as well as many other life lessons, that it is only fitting to come home, so to speak, to play the organ in the chapel again.
