Is Our Creator The **God Of This World?**

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth" Genesis 1:1). Further enlightenment in the Gospel of John, speaking of Jesus, tells us in chapter one that "all things were made by Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made." Historic Christianity builds from this foundation a gospel of God's love which leads us to answers of the tough questions in life, if we look for them. Furthermore, the Scriptures (our Bible) reveal a plan that shows a higher plan and purpose. When I read the following, I was looking head on at one of these tough questions.

"And God? Where was God when we needed Him? ... In Auschwitz, there was no God. Where was He when those young women, those girls, were hanged and we were forced to watch? Where was He when that young boy (who was to be gassed) smiled back at me? Where was He when thousands perished?" These words were recorded in Paul Glaser's book, "Dancing with the Enemy, my fam-ily's Holocaust Secret," written about his aunt Rosie who survived from her internment by the Nazis death camp at Auschwitz. She did not consider herself to be a Jew because she had been a nominal Catholic, but because her father was Jewish, she and her family were arrested in a program of the Nazi to exterminate the jews from the face of the earth.

I do not see Auschwitz as the work of a loving creator, but of the devil himself seeking to destroy the people he hates. Too often, reality is hard to accept. As I write this article, the Michael Brown incident in Ferguson, Missouri, is on the news with a controversy developing and escalating. Iran and Iraq are on record among others to remove Israel from the face of the earth. The very existence of Israel today and its continuing survival testifies to the miracles in its history of the presence and power of God. Yet, we continue to want to move on looking for some other answer that will ignore Israel, the Bible and Jesus Christ Himself

Does the survival of the Bible itself over all the attempts recorded in history to keep it out of the hands of the common people attest to God's love to communicate with His creation? Can the life of Christ with eyewitnesses testifying to His life and resurrection be equaled by any other religion? Is this communication a result of man's reasoning power or did God through the inspired Scriptures reveal truth to us? If by ignoring these observations will one only create greater questions that cannot be answered?

Have we ignored that there is a god of this world who is not a loving Creator? That such an evil and terrible devil exists who hates the Creator and his creation? That by deception and lying he took away from man in the garden the creation prepared for him? Does such a god of this world exist as described by Jesus as a murderer and the father of lies? Does

such an evil power exist that can deceive the rulers of nations throughout history, as tought in the book of Daniel and other scriptures? Is it to such an extent that the world is dominated by evil today?

How successful has the God of This World been? As I look around this area I see a former Christian College campus here in our city transformed into a Federal minimum security prison camp. Over in nearby Springfield a former States Teacher's College is now a state medium security prison. Our jails are being filled to capacity with angry and addicted people trying to find purpose and accountability. The majority of these appear to me to be young, separated from loved ones, confused and angry. I believe that without Christ, there is a void in life that only He can fill.

The tragic death of Robin Williams is making us ask these questions that are hard to answer. Depression can destroy us and the subject I have bought up leads me to share this as I have faced depression and have found meditating on the 23rd Psalm and the Lord's Prayer far out does anything else available, religious or otherwise to bring peace within myself. I do not need to count sheep, but just talk to the good shepherd!

In closing it is my request that we need to pray for and support our churches and their pastors, praying for good communication with our Creator, our community, and between the churches themselves!
