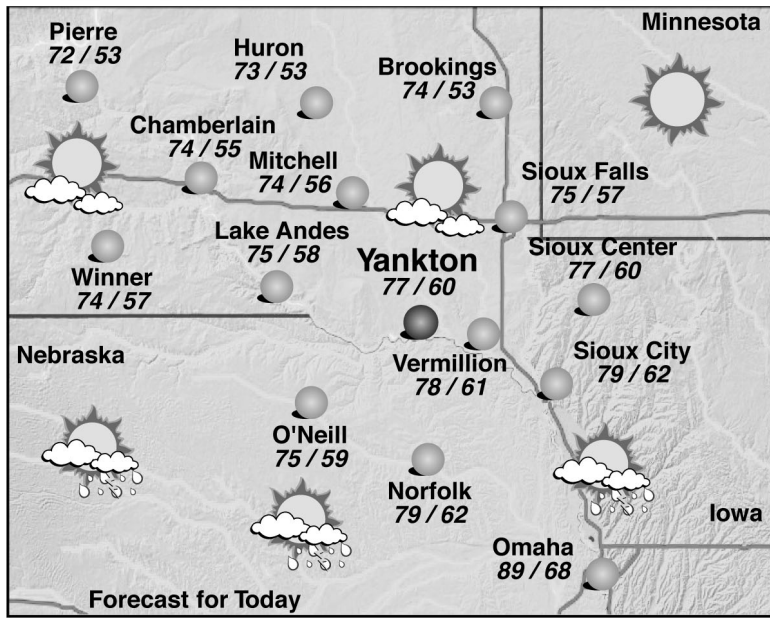

Remember City Election-Sign Ordinance

Yankton ordinance states that election signs and other temporary signs may be posted on private property up to 75 days before an event and must be removed within seven days after.
A good general rule is to keep election signs to the inside (house side) of the public sidewalk or about 15 feet from the roadside curb if there is no sidewalk.

LINCOLN, Neb. — The Nebraska Department of Roads Highway U.S. 81 repair project that begins at the US-81/N-12 Junction and proceeds north approximately 8 miles to the US-81/N-12 Junction is nearing the third and final phase.
Repairs to the bridge, located approximately three miles north of the Highway N-12 Junction, should be completed the last week in August, weather permitting.
