Mead Update

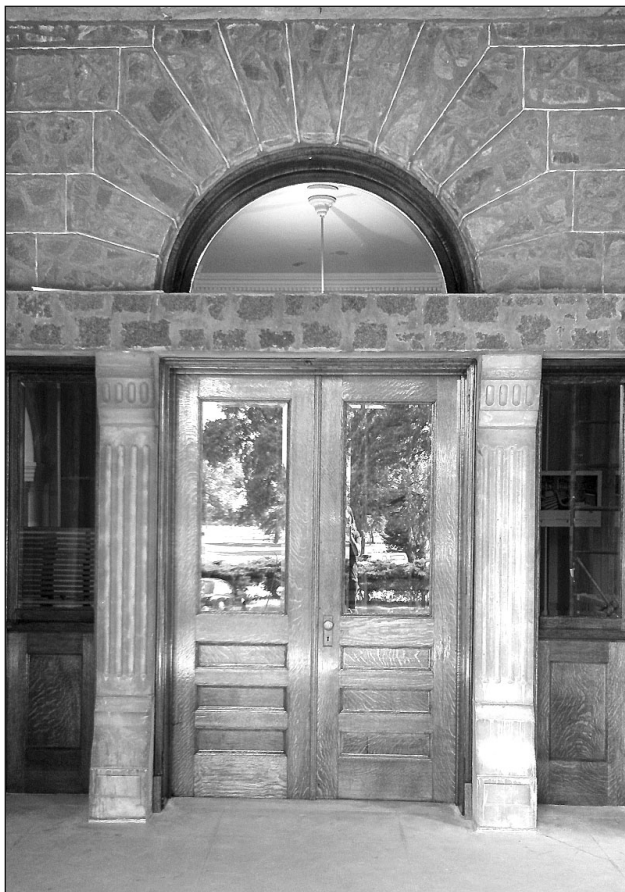
