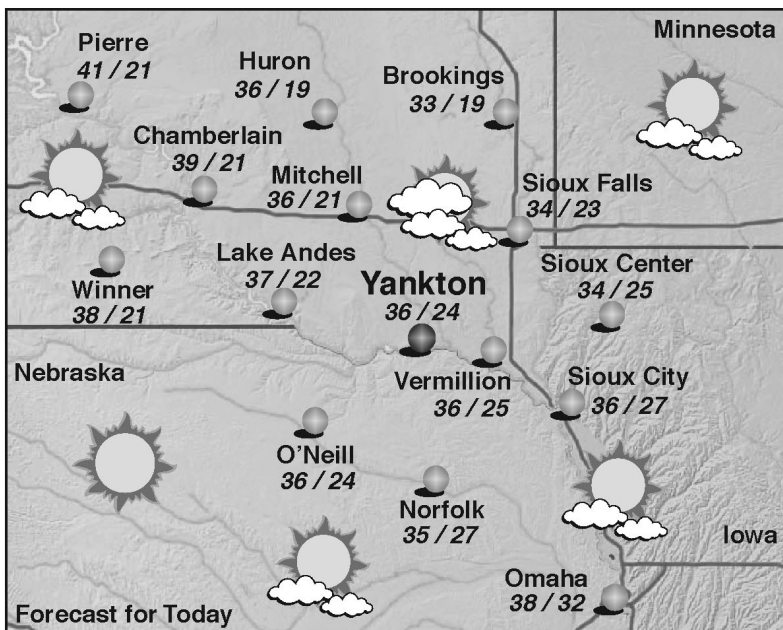

and physicians who told us that the most important aspect of our layout for efficiency would be to have all the clinical services on the first floor.

The surgery expansion which will be completed in July 2012 is just finishing the second of two phases.

According to Ekeren there will soon be six new surgery rooms with the first to go into operation next month.

"The first phase was the new pre- and post-op rooms, recovery, nurses station and physician

locker rooms, which opened up July of this summer," he said. "We are now in the second phase, which is building and equipping four of the new operating rooms.

"Our pharmacy and biomedical services currently share spaces on the third floor of the hospital and really, there is only room for one of them," Ekeren said.

Ekeren said the target completion for the Northern Lights project is approximately 24 months.

materials and supplies, rose to 60.9 from October's 56. On average, supply managers anticipate the cost of the goods they purchase will increase by 3.7 percent over the next six months...

"Last February when we asked the same question, supply managers expected annualized price growth of 8.8 percent," Goss said. "Thus, anticipated wholesale price growth has declined by 1.5 percentage points since February."

The report indicated business

leaders surveyed remain pessimistic about economic prospects for the first half of 2012. The November business confidence index sank to 49.1 from October's already weak 49.5.

The inventory index climbed to 52.9 from October's 48.5. The export index rose to 52.1 from October's 50, while the import index rose to 49.5 from October's anemic 48.

The other components of the November index were: — New orders at 52, up from October's 51.2; — Production or sales at 52.4, up from October's 48.5; — Delivery lead time at 56.5, down from October's 57.9.

Pearl Harbor Memorial Service Set For Sat.

Two World War Two veterans will speak about their experiences Saturday, Dec. 3, during the annual Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day program hosted by a local veterans organization.

The Grand du South Dakota, Lewis & Clark Voiture 842, of La Societe des Quarante Hommes et Huit Chevaux (The Society of 40 Men and 8 Horses), commonly known as the "40 & 8," will begin the ceremony at 6 p.m. Friday in the Yankton VFW Post located at 209 Cedar St., Yankton.

In addition to a memorial service, speakers will include veteran Harold Reinschmidt, who farmed near Wagner and now lives in Yankton. He served from 1944-1945 in France and was transported in one of the box cars for which the 40 & 8 is named.

A second speaker, Darrel Christopherson of Vermillion, served from Feb. 12, 1941, to 1963. During the attack on Pearl Harbor, his ship, the USS Vestal AR 4, was tied up next to the USS Arizona.

Also, Irene English Lammers from Nebraska will share the story of her childhood living in Germany under Adolf Hitler from age 7 to 12, when she and her sister were separated from the rest of their family. In addition, South Dakota Lt. Gov. Matt Michels will speak about Pearl Harbor.

The evening will end with the playing of "Taps."
