WAGNER — Try as he might, Alex Kocer has been unable to avoid the state spotlight for his accolades on the wrestling mat.

It's just not possible when you've put together the kind of career the Wagner senior has assembled.

Four individual state titles. Three team championships.

But now, Kocer is about to feel the spotlight burn even brighter as he begins his senior year with a chance to win his fifth straight state title — and in the process, join rare company.

"I've thought about it, sure," he said before a pre-season practice outside Wagner's red-clad wrestling room. "It's a cool thought.

"It doesn't always happen, because every year has been tougher."

Kocer has won championships at 103 pounds (2008), 119 (2009), 130 (2010) and 152 last season as a junior.

Only four other South Dakota wrestlers have won five straight state titles. Kirk Wallman of Freeman (1984-89) and Logan Storley of Webster Area (2006-11) both won six straight — two of the three in U.S. history to accomplish that feat.

Lincoln McIllravy of Philip (1988-92) and Hannon Hisek of Bon Homme (1994-98) each captured five straight titles.

Put another way, Kocer could join exclusive company with a strong senior season. "He doesn't ever bring it up,

but just by the things he does, I think he feels it a little bit," said Wagner first-year coach Chas Welch, who pointed to Kocer's increased summer workout habits as proof.

"The crazy thing is, he's about the most carefree kid you can ever meet.'

Even with all his success, Kocer has, for the most part, done so quietly, without much hoopla.
