the possibility of proposing an ordinance change in the future that would allow the discharge of certain fireworks within limited hours during the two fireworks seasons.
 “I think, in fairness to the community and the fireworks retail-

ers, we have to at least take a look at an ordinance change. Maybe it won’t be a good deal, but we should at least talk about it,” Nickles said. “We have no place to direct people when they ask us where they can shoot. There are some other places that are (allowing fireworks), and it’s working out fine.”
 One thing it would do is eliminate many of the fireworks complaints the police department has to deal with during the fireworks

season, he stated.
 For those shooting fireworks during the upcoming holiday outside the city limits, Nickles encourages them to do it in a disked field or other area where there isn’t a chance of a grass fire igniting.
 “Normally, there would be snow on the ground, and you wouldn’t even worry about it,” he said. “Now, we’re hoping we don’t have guys out over the New Year’s holiday fighting grass fires.”

Large Fight Turns To Melee At Mall Of America

BLOOMINGTON, Minn. (AP) — A moving melee involving scores of juveniles at the Mall of America took police and mall security more than an hour to control Monday as shoppers packed the sprawling shopping center the day after Christmas, a mall official said.
 The incident began as a fight involving about 50 juveniles in a food court about 4:20 p.m., mall spokeswoman Bridget Jewell told the *Star Tribune*. Then, dozens of young

people swarmed through the mall, some grabbing items from shoppers and kiosks as many mall visitors ran into stores to get out of the way, witnesses said.
 “It looked like they were trying to pull people’s stuff out of their bags,” said shopper Makenzie Shofner, 15, of Maple Plain. “My heart was racing.”
 Shofner’s friend, 16-year-old Hannah Betz of Maple Plain, said it was incredibly loud.

“I’m used to some of the screaming because this is the Mall of America,” which has amusement park rides, she said. “But this was a different kind of screaming.”
 Police brought it under control about 5:30 p.m.
 Mall officials said there were no lockdowns, no one was hurt and no weapons were involved. However, some stores did close their internal entrances to the mall during the incident.
