that has been achieved in the fifth and sixth grade rooms.

"We are working our way down," Kaiser said. "We decided to start with the older kids because they are bigger and the desks that we are getting have the chairs separate from the desk. Also, some of the older classrooms are our larger size classes. Some of the classrooms were short on desks, so the school has had to use tables and chairs for some students."

The goal of the WPA is to come up with at least \$15,000. Approximately \$7,000 has been raised already.

"We have done different fundraisers," Kaiser said. "We do a pop sale fund raiser. We had a concession stand during Labor Day. We had a penny year in school grades K-6, where I just put a jar in their rooms and the winning classroom got a pizza party. The students brought in more than roughly \$1,000 from kids bringing in their change and whatever they wanted to put in there. We have also had several anonymous donations that have helped tremendously."

With the penny wars, Kaiser said the students were able to participate in the project and see a direct result of their efforts.

"The kids are very excited," she said. "When I took the pizza to the winning class — which was the fourth grade — the teacher was telling them that we purchased new desks. It was fun and exciting to see something like that coming into the school for them."

Because the community is small, the Parent Association tries to take on a bigger project each year, Kaiser said.

After completing a major playground renovation, the WPA last year chose to purchase the school a Cri-cut Cutter for cutting out shapes and letters, and Kaiser said there is always more on the horizon.

"Fundraisers we have done in the past and may do yet again this year include a carnival some years; we did a bingo night and served a meal last year and we raffled off theme baskets," she said.

Kaiser added if the group raises more than its goal of \$15,000 to purchase the desks, the extra money will be used to purchase new tables for the lunch room.

A donation plaque will be posted in the hallway of the elementary school for those who have donated to one of the following levels — although any amount is appreciated:

- \$150 (1 desk) — Student
- \$600 (4 desks) — Teacher
- \$1,000 (7 desks) — Principal
- \$2,000 (14 desks) — Superintendent
- \$3,000 (20 desks) — Classroom

great pride in his membership in the 2005 "Gang of 14," made up of Republicans and Democrats who brokered a deal to avoid a filibuster showdown over President George W. Bush's judicial nominees.

However, Nelson's vote in favor of Obama's signature health reform measure left the GOP confident they could beat the Democrat next year. The health reforms are strongly opposed by many Nebraska conservatives, and after the vote Nebraska Republicans immediately kicked off a "Give Ben the Boot" campaign.

"For once Senator Nelson has listened to Nebraskans," Nebraska Republican Party Chairman Mark Fahleson said Tuesday. "The Nebraska Republican Party is more focused than ever on electing another conservative Republican to join Sen. Mike Johanns and recapturing the U.S. Senate so that we can reverse the damage done by Ben Nelson, Washington Democrats and the Obama Administration."

of Nebraska for over two decades," while Fischer expressed confidence the GOP would now claim the seat.

Nelson first was elected to the Senate in 2000, defeating Republican contender Stenberg to replace the retired Bob Kerrey. His centrist stance helped him get re-elected over the years even as Nebraska became even more dominated by Republicans.

"In one respect, he certainly deserves to have some time away from the political scene," said Democratic super-delegate Steve Achelpohl. "But on the other hand, it certainly is going to leave a void."

He was one of only two Senate Democrats to support a failed GOP bid to block new federal controls on power plant pollution that blows downwind into other states. And he took
