Creek (reservation)," Trudell said. "And then later, we ended up here." In April 1863, Congress passed a law expelling the

Dakota people entirely from the state of Minnesota. 'That law still hasn't been changed, only Congress can change it," Trudell added.

This year marks the 150th anniversary of the 38 Dakota executed in Minnesota, and Thomas said she hopes to make the horseback ride a part of the memorial each year.
