Former Gazelle, Jackrabbit **Adjusting To Life On The Bench**

RAPID CITY — If it looked as though Ketty Paula was chomping at the bit to take the court and defend her former rivals, it's because she Those days are gone for

the Yankton native and former basketball standout at South Dakota State. Now an assistant women's

basketball coach at South Dakota School of Mines under head coach Ryan Larsen, Paula — formerly Cornemann — is relegated to teaching players from the bench.

"If we could, we both would have jumped out on the court and defended them the way we wanted our girls to," Paula said after Saturday's 81-49 loss to the University of South Dakota at the Rushmore Plaza Civic Center in Rapid City.

Paula, who played at SDSU from 2006-10, was hired by Larsen — a former USD assistant — in August. The duo was faced with the prospect of playing the Coyotes in Rapid City, when the Division I school moved a home doubleheader.

As such, both coaches had their own personal connections to the game.

"I was actually really excited to see them on the schedule, because I knew it would be a neat opportunity for our girls," Paula said. "It's just exciting to see Coyotes on the other side. I love competing against them."

Added Larsen, when hearing Paula talk about the Coyotes, "She's never lost to USD, until tonight.

"Not in basketball, no." quipped a smiling Paula.

That's the kind of relationship the two coaches have, she said: Ultra competitive with a mutual enjoyment of spending so much time together.

"I owe coach Larsen a big

"And I really appreciate how much responsibility he gives me and how much he trusts my suggestions. I've learned a ton from him in a short couple months."

Still, there was a big difference between taking instruction and instructing, Paula added.

"I had hesitations, definitely, thinking I wasn't qualified enough," she said. "And Ryan quickly made sure I understood I was ready to

coach in college. "That I had a lot to offer

these girls and this program. Not only Paula helped the

Jackrabbits reach the WNIT and NCAA tournaments during her college career, she previously served as a volunteer coach at Mines during the 2011-12 season.

And before taking the job at Mines, Paula was a teacher and assistant girls' basketball coach at Rapid City Stevens.

But when it came time to really get involved in day-today operations of a college program, Paula admitted that, ves. there were adjustments from what she was used to at the D-1 level at "Even just from an ath-

letic program standpoint, we came from two very organized and developed programs," she said. "You had to

justed pretty well." On a personal level, Paula is nearing another major ad-

justment. She and her husband, Jordan, are expecting a baby next March. Paula said she was hesitant in taking the Mines job because she would miss the final stretch of the season — she will not travel

for the final three road trips. Again, she complimented Larsen, saying, "He said we would make it work, which was a relief to hear, obviously.

Making it work on the court, though, has proven to be a study in patience for both coaches. The Lady Hardrockers are 3-7 after Saturday's loss to USD.

"Our problem right now is we kind of take a step forward and two steps back,' Larsen said. "That's frustrating from a coaching standpoint, because you see them do things right and then you have a total breakdown."

That's where the whole 'patience is a virtue' thing comes into play, he added. "We're getting better, just

not nearly as fast as we'd like Such is life for a team that

is rather young. Mines boasts seven freshmen, five sophomores, three juniors and one senior on its 2013-14 roster. "We've said this a ton this

season, but basically they're all freshmen because they're all new to our program," Paula said. "New to what Ryan and I are trying to de-In time, with development

of the current players and recruiting, the Lady Hardrockers should turn a corner, Paula added. 'We just need more time.
