Mead Update

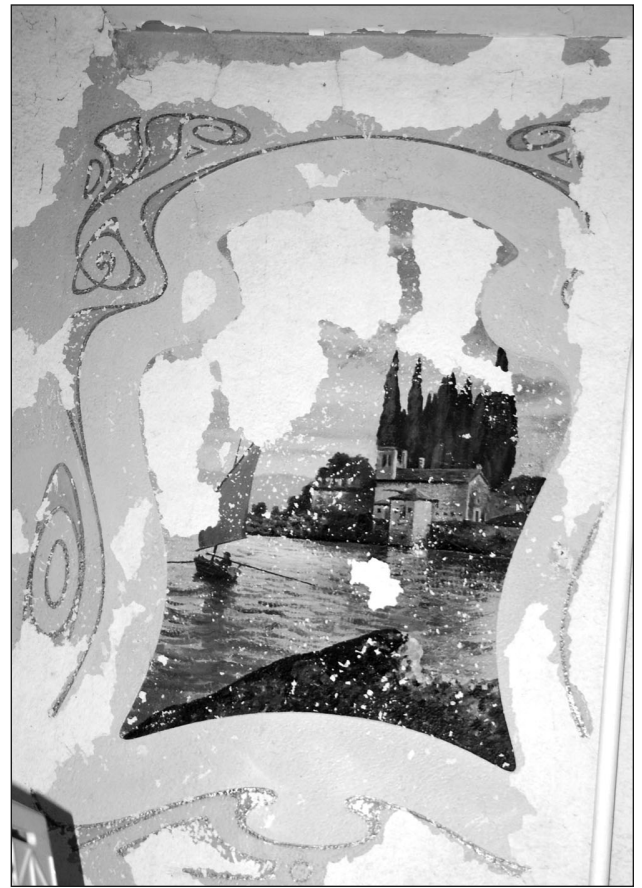
