


Cramer-Kenyon Home **Opens Its Doors** For The Holidays This Weekend

This year, Veronica Trezona's residence has taken on a simpler look for Christmas.

a simpler look for cirristinas. Then again, "simpler" still means elegant when you live in the historic Cramer-Kenyon Heritage Home. The 1886 house stands at 509 Pine Street in Yankton. Trezona resides in the original "servant's quarters" as caretaker for the home, which dates back to Dakota Territory days.

"It was the tallest Queen Anne (style building) in the territory when it was built," she said.

Besides maintaining the home, she offers tours from Memorial Day to Labor Day with other times by appointment.

Now, visitors don't need to wait until next spring to tour the home.

In the holiday spirit, the Cramer-Kenyon board of directors is offering its annual Holiday Tours and Open Houses at the historic Eastlake Stick Style home. The public is welcome to attend the event, set for 5-7 p.m. tonight (Friday) and 1-4 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. The annual event is free. However, donations will

be accepted. Visitors can enter either the front or rear door. Parking can be found in the back lot, and the kitchen entrance offers a lift for those with difficulty walking up the stairs.

Cramer-Kenyon board members will greet visitors, who can also meet Trezona. The hosts will serve beverages and homemade cookies as part of the holiday atmosphere. Children are welcome, but good behavior is expected.

No reservations are needed. Visitors are encouraged to bring their cameras, as the home is always cameraready.

"We are dedicating this weekend to Margaret Lyons, our (board) treasurer who recently died," Trezona said. "All of the money donated will be in her name."

#### A SIMPLER LOOK
