South Dakota Men Score 2 OT

Win At Milwaukee

MILWAUKEE (AP) — Tre Burnette scored the game winner with 12 seconds left in second overtime to give South Dakota a 92-91 victory over Milwaukee on Thursday night.

Burnette got open in the lane off a South Dakota (7-4) inbound play after Milwaukee's Matt Tiby turned it over with 5.6 seconds left. Tiby secured a defensive rebound off Trey Norris' miss but fell to the ground for a travelling violation.

Tiby, who finished with 31 points and 17 rebounds, had just given the Panthers (8-4) the lead with 14 seconds to play. He also passed 1,000 career points.

D.J. Davis and Tyler Hagedorn led the Coyotes with 17 points each. Davis also grabbed 10 boards.

Austin Arians had 16 points and Akeem Springs 13 for Milwaukee.

The Panthers appeared to win off Springs' tip-in with less than a second left in first overtime, but the referees reviewed and determined the shot clock had already expired.

SDSU's Wieneke Racks Up Third

All-American Honor

NEW HAVEN, Conn. — South Dakota State University wide receiver Jake Wieneke continues to rack up postseason awards as he was named to his third Football Championship Subdivision All-America team of the week on Friday, earning recognition on the Walter Camp FCS All-America Team. The team was selected by FCS head coaches and sports information directors, and certified by the accounting and auditing firm, Marcum LLP.

A sophomore from Maple Grove, Minnesota, Wieneke led the Jackrabbits with 72 receptions for 1,472 yards and 11 touchdowns during the recently completed 2015 season. He currently ranks second among FCS players for receiving yards

and receiving yards per game (122.7). His average of 20.44 yards per reception also ranks fourth.

Through two seasons at SDSU, Wieneke ranks second in career touchdown receptions (27), third in career receiving yards (2,876) and sixth with 145 career receptions. The owner of two of the top three single-season receiving yardage totals in program history, Wieneke named to All-America first teams selected by STATS and the Associated Press earlier in the week.

South Dakota State ended the 2015 season with an 8-4 overall record and made its fourth consecutive appearance in the FCS playoffs.
