SHREVEPORT, La. — South Dakota State shot a school-record 64.7 percent from the field, led by a 9-11 night by Kelly Corneman, in a 92-50 rout of Centenary in Summit League women's basketball action Monday.

Corneman, a senior from Yankton, scored a career-high 25 points, hitting all six of her three-point attempts. Maria Boever and Ashley Eide each had 14 points. Jennie Singsaard added 11 points in the win.
