God was waiting for me when I got home. I gave Him a nod as I took off my coat, then I went straight to the kitchen to see what I could put together for supper. He followed me. "Long day?" "Yeah. Sure was." "You seem stressed. What's up?" "I don't know. It's everything. It's the news. It's work. It's doctors. It's bills. Everything is so fast, so loud, so demanding. You think something's settled and it isn't. New problems come up before the old ones go away." I must have gone on for awhile. God sat down and listened. I closed the cupboard door and sat down opposite Him. I told Him about my schedule, my frustrations. I talked about my worries and my fears.

I finally said, "It's all such a struggle. Even

I asked that my son be released from his addiction. None of those things have happened yet. Haven't you been paying attention?"

I might have been a little defensive. God said, "Wait. You've asked for things. You prayed for results, for outcomes. I need you to talk to Me like you did a few minutes ago. Tell me about your fears and your hopes. Talk to

me about your worries. Share your struggles with me. You don't have to tell me what outcomes to bring about. I know all about the outcome. I win. And if I win, you do too."

I had to pause. "So what am I praying for?" He looked me in the eye. "I pray for the in-between time. For the ability to get past the present struggles. For faith. For strength. For guidance."

For hope. For yourself and for others. For reminders that the victory is sure. For the ability to accomplish something good even in evil times.

For forgiveness. For the assurance that I am with you in every circumstance. The question is not so much "What do you need in the end?", but "what do you need to make it through 'til the morning?"

He nodded.
