chuckle. In that game, she scored 26 points to guide USD to an 87-83 victory.

"The SDSU fans behind their bench were throwing carrots out on the court," she added. "There's a rumor that it was actually a USD person doing it, but they couldn't find out who did it. We were getting pretty frustrated; the game was so close."

Six years later, the Coyotes and Jackrabbits will take to the court again. Though the circumstances have changed and the games might not mean as much, Olson said once the clock starts running, all bets are off.

"I think it'll take a little bit for the kids to get that rivalry back," Olson said. "There's such a tradition with it. It might be the alumni who will get fired up first, but you know the players will be pumped too."

For this contest, there are a total of 13 in-state products among the combined 29 players on the USD and SDSU rosters. Yet, as Koupal said, even those out-of-state players know by now the State-U lore.

"It'll be neat for these kids that are playing now, on both sides," she said. "I know our girls have talked about it and how anxious they are. But it's always just been stories. They've never experienced a game like that."

"But now they can." Though the crowd may not hold the same feelings they once had for the hated Coyotes, Olson said she recalls a situation where USD freshmen were welcomed to the rivalry in a quick way.

"I remember my senior year when we were up in Brookings, we got booed so bad coming off the bus," she said. "We had two red-shirt freshmen along, and their eyes got so big. They had no idea about the passion."

Added Koupal, "It's hard to know what to expect up there. I guarantee you it'll be rowdy, but hopefully it starts off on a good note."

With the start to an already anticipated rivalry that picks up consistency when USD joins The Summit League in 2011-12 comes the ultimate question on the minds of fans.

Who wins the game? For Olson, who admits SDSU has the upper hand in experience and of course, home court, the final decision could be closer than most expect.

"That's a tough question, but it might be interesting; I'll say that," she said. "The USD girls have never seen an atmosphere like that. I think it'll be very close."

"But I've got to go for the 'Yotes."
