career wins record at SDSU with 137, and was named S.D. Athlete of the Year in 2001.

Lamer wrestled for Tri-Valley and was a two-time state champion in 1990-91. He was a four-time All-American at SDSU and was a national champion in 1994, 1995 and 1996. He finished second in 2001 and 2002 at the U.S. Freestyle World Team Trials. He was a University World Champion in 2000 in Tokyo, Japan.

Harty was a three-time 285-pound state champion for lead from 1990-92. He was a four-time All-American at heavyweight at the University of North Carolina. He was a four-time Atlantic Coast Conference champion and the 1996 ACC Wrestler of the Year.

Larson, who wrestled one year at varsity for West Central, is a long-time athlete, coach, organizer and promoter. He spent 18 years as coach and was a founding member of Midwest Wrestling. Larson is still active in the club and helps out with area tournaments.

Lager was a six-year varsity wrestler for Miller from 1980-85, where he competed in five state tournaments. He was a state champion in 1984 and 1985. His career record was 171-18-7 and in 1985 set the South Dakota record for career wins and career pins (91). Lager was later a four-year varsity wrestler at Northern State.

The state championships will be held Feb. 26-27, with Class A in Rapid City and Class B in Sioux Falls.
