

1 Arrested In Sioux Falls Standoff

SIoux FALLS (AP) — A 12-hour standoff in a Sioux Falls neighborhood has ended, and one man has been arrested.

Sioux Falls police identified him as 57-year-old Michael Pickering.

Officers were called to Pickering's home on the north side of the city about 2:30 a.m. Sunday to discuss whether he was allowed to own firearms because of his criminal history. Once the officers arrived, police

say, they found Pickering had barricaded his door shut with what appeared to be electronics equipment and a gas can.

Police say Pickering refused to come out and a standoff ensued. He was arrested about 2 p.m.

Pickering was being held Sunday by the U.S. Marshals Service for a probation violation.

No number for Pickering was listed. It wasn't immediately known whether he had an attorney.

Neb. Official: Driver Not Told To Restrain Teen

HERSHEY, Neb. (AP) — The state-contracted transport company involved in the escape of a Lexington teen en route to a Panhandle detention center was not told to handcuff or shackle him during the trip, a state official has confirmed.

Todd Reckling, director of the Division of Children & Family Services, said Friday his office was still reviewing the Feb. 13 incident but has already determined Prince of the Road wasn't cautioned to use restraints.

The teen was arrested in Lexington for "uncontrollable juvenile issues." The 16-year-

old bolted during a bathroom break at a Hershey convenience store, about a third of the way into the 215-mile trip to the Scottsbluff/Gering area, the Lincoln County sheriff's office said.

The sheriff's office said Saturday that the teen has since been found. Lexington police said officers found the teen Friday night while investigating a party in the city. He was among several teens arrested for underage drinking, police said.

Authorities have said the teen should have been restrained during the trip because of his

history of assaults, car thefts and escapes.

But Jim Lautenkols, chief executive officer of Ravenna-based Prince of the Road, said his staff was never told the teen needed restraints or was likely to escape. He said the Health and Human Services Department indicated the boy was "a typical ornery teen" when Lautenkols' dispatcher asked whether the boy was a high-risk transport.

Lautenkols said the teen requested a bathroom break, then bolted from the driver.

"He just simply ran away," Lautenkols said.
