The Missouri National Recreational River is a national park that runs right through Yankton. You will discover stretches of the Wild and Scenic Missouri River, plenty of outdoor activities, miles of trails for hiking, biking and running, many

wayside exhibits throughout the river corridor and a variety of historic sites and cultural activities. View the natural beauty and learn some of the diverse history of the recreational river along 100 miles of the South Dakota-Nebraska border. The National Park Service offers a variety of programs at the park and partner sites throughout the River Corridor for children, families, teachers and school field trip groups. Summer programming includes Junior Ranger and other programs for youth; guided walks, evening programs, canoe programs, fishing clinics, visitor center programs at the Lewis & Clark Visitor Center, an exhibit at the Yankton Chamber & Visitors Center and more.
