CHICAGO (AP) — Grains futures traded mixed Wednesday on the Chicago Board of Trade.
Wheat for March delivery fell 1.50 cent to \$6.6075 a bushel; March corn rose 0.25 cent to \$6.4250 a bushel; March oats rose 0.25 cent to \$3.28 a bushel; while March soybeans fell 0.50 cent to \$12.3150 a bushel.
Beef and pork futures also traded mixed on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange.
April live cattle rose 0.23 cent to \$1.2880 a pound; March feeder cattle rose 0.27 cent to \$1.5527 a pound; while April lean hogs fell 0.15 cent to 88.95 cents a pound.
