

Hegge Named Summit League Player Of The Week For 4th Time

ELMHURST, Ill. — South Dakota senior Amber Hegge has been named the Summit League Player of the Week in women's basketball, the league announced on Tuesday. It's the fourth honor of the season for Hegge and the seventh time that she has received a weekly conference player of the week honor in her career.

Hegge (Crofton, Neb.) received the honor after an outstanding week in helping the Coyotes to a 3-0 record, including wins over rivals South Dakota State and North Dakota State. She averaged 23.3 points, 7.3 rebounds, 3.7 assists, 1.7 blocks and 1.3 steals per game. She also had a 5.5 assist/turnover ratio. Hegge had 28 points against both NDSU and SDSU and recorded her ninth double-double of the season in the victory over the Bison (28 points, 12 rebounds). Hegge shot 50 percent from the field (26-of-52) and 64 percent from the three-point line (7-of-11).

Hegge leads the Coyotes in scoring (19.1 points per game), rebounding (8.5 per game), is tied for the team lead in steals (39) and leads the starting lineup with a 53 percent field-goal percentage. She is also shooting 40.5 percent from three-point range, best on the team, and is second on the team in assists with 8.7.

The Coyotes (18-6, 9-5 Summit League) return to action Saturday at Indiana University-Purdue University-Indianapolis.

She has been a part of conference championship teams in 2009 and 2010, as well as a state-qualifying squad in 2010.

"Allison is the true forward that we need here at Mount Marty. She is very aggressive and puts a lot of pressure on opposing defenses," said Mount Marty soccer coach Nathan Epp. "Her ability to stretch the field, score, and will-ness to get the assist will instantly make her a threat to teams up front for us. She has all of the characteristics that we are looking for in our forwards."
