always seem to step up to the plate."

Sternhagen said the YAIA has received a great deal of support for the tournament from outside the organization, as well.

"Yankton's just been really awesome in general," she said. 'The community has been really supportive for items for raffles and donations for concessions; Walmart donated some towels; the Chamber gave us bags — it's been just a great joint effort from the whole community."

While much of the work has been completed, there is still plenty to go, and the YAIA continues to seek volunteers, Sternhagen said.

"Anybody that wants to come help can contact us," she said. "We'll take help from anybody that wants to volunteer." Those interested in helping with the tournament, donat-

ing door prizes or participating in other ways can contact Sternhagen at 605-660-8515.

Despite the hurried organization, Baumeister said the YAIA is excited about the opportunity to host such an event.

'It's the highest level of tournament that we've been able to host in Yankton, and given the fact that this is really only our seventh year of tournament play, I think it's a milestone for us," she said. "This gives us an opportunity to show the community what we have to offer, and also show the rest of the ice associations across the state what we can offer as far as tournaments go.'

Sternhagen said one of the best parts of hosting the tournament is that it means the seniors on the Yankton team will play their final game at home.

This has been pretty much a core group," she said. "All these girls but one have been competing for, I think, five years now. It's a great group, and they'll be missed. About a third of our team will be graduating soon, and they'll be playing their last game in Yankton. It's pretty fun.'

"When they found out (Yankton was hosting the tournament), they were ecstatic," added Yankton Head Coach Mike Freeman. "The very last game that they'll play for Yankton will be on their home ice."

Freeman said along with the sentimental benefits, holding the tournament in Yankton should also help the players during the competition.

'It's definitely going to be better for the kids," he said. "They're going to be able to sleep in their own beds, and we won't have to travel out of town.

Despite gaining an advantage, Freeman said he was unsure of how the team will perform.

'If you would have asked me a month ago, I would have said our chances are pretty good. But for some reason, we've fallen into a slump for the last three weeks," he said. "I still think our chances are good. I know what our potential is, and we can compete with the other teams.

Freeman said he hopes the tournament atmosphere will help the team bust out of its slump, something that often happens at the professional level.

You see this in the Stanley Cup," he said. "When the finals start, it seems like everyone starts to pick their game up because it's a do-or-die situation."

Yankton will open the tournament with its first game Friday at 4 p.m. at the Kiwanis 4-H Ice Center. Games will follow at 6 p.m. and 8 p.m. Saturday begins with opening ceremonies at 10:30 a.m., including an introduction of the seven participating teams and the presentation of league awards. "Come and see what girls hockey is about in Yankton," Sternhagen said. "We'd like to invite younger girls to come and see it's not what they might think — that's it's rough and where they'll get hurt. It's a fun, fast-moving sport, and the girls have a lot of skill to be able to move around on the ice and shoot the puck. It's amazing to watch.'


