

million, for two-year optout on Tuesday, the district is projecting a net increase of \$1.146/\$1,000 increase for non-owner-occupied property, no increase for home-owner occupied and a net decrease of \$0.405/\$1,000 on ag property for taxes payable in the year 2013.

"Recent history has shown us that the overall dollar-per-thousand levies, if anything, will go down," Bietz said. "We don't know what the 2012 evaluations will be and we have acknowledged that. We don't control individual people's tax assessments. So, we are using what we currently know. What we do know is to use the dollar per thousand formula, which is set in law — the current local tax effort plus the per-student allocation that the state sets.'

Bietz added that the district chose to project on the high side, rather than the low so, and if anything, the amounts collected would more than likely be less than what the district is projecting.

'If there is any growth at all in the tax base, the dollar-per-thousand amount of the opt-out could be less than what we are saying," he said. "We want to be as accurate as we can reasonably be."

O: What, if any, expenses does the Yankton School District (YSD) pay for Sacred Heart Schools? For example, I have heard that they provide textbooks, Ťitle I dollars, Special Education (SPED) funding, middle school activities such as choir and orchestra, and transportation. A: Currently, the Yank-

ton School District provides all of the above to non-Yankton Public students including Sacred Heart Schools. Both state and federal

laws mandate these provisions. Title I, Reading Recov-

erv and SPED funding are mandated by federal laws. In December of each year, Sacred Heart School provides YSD with the number of students that will require services under the SPED federal programs. Funding received by the district reflects those students, and services are provided for those students with those moneys. Transportation for those students, if needed, to one of the public school facilities is required to be supplied by YSD.

Title I and Reading Recovery are similar, except they are based on the number of low-income students in the school. State law requires that

the Yankton School District provide textbooks to any student in the district who requests it. This means that any home-schooled student or private-schooled student can request a textbook for any class at their grade level they choose, and the district must loan them to the student.

Currently, according to school officials, Sacred Heart students do utilize textbooks from the Yankton School District, as well as many home-schooled students. However, YSD does not supply workbooks or teacher's manuals.

In regard to supplying middle school (and elementary school) access to activities provided by YSD for non-public school students, currently the district covers those charges. However, once a student reaches high school level, they must be enrolled at Yankton High School to participate because of the school's affiliation with the South Dakota High School Activities Association.
